## 2023 COMMUNITY IMPACT

To support the communities where we live and work, Leprino Foods Company's Lemoore employees and the Leprino Foods Company Foundation (LFCF) annually partner with local nonprofit and other organizations to provide philanthropic donations and volunteer support.
